We want to think about how we can best use this information.



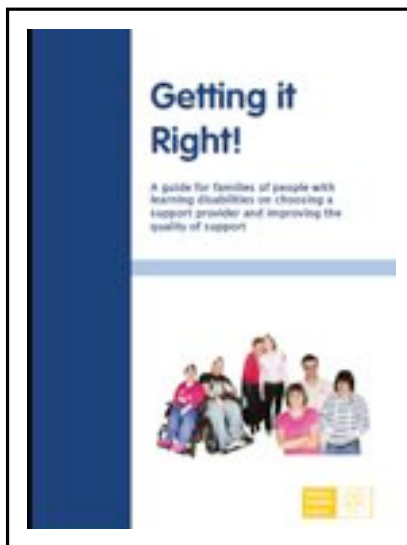
We want to find out what else would be useful
